
Scientific Activities of the Department of Special Education: Scientific Activities of the Department of Special Education:

Among the activities provided by the department to the university and related to the women's empowerment program, the College of Basic Education at the University of Dhi Qar, in cooperation with the Women's Empowerment Unit at our university, held an educational dialogue seminar entitled: (Women's rights between equality and justice in Islamic Sharia, positive laws and international covenants).

The symposium started with an opening speech by the Associate Dean for Administrative Affairs, Prof. Dr. Muhammad

Qassem Hussein, and a speech by the Head of the Special Education Department, Prof. Dr. Ali Muhammad Assi.

The seminar was moderated by Ms. Azhar Abed Raysan and a group of female students in the Department of Special Education.

A number of important topics were addressed, summarized in four main themes:

The first axis: women's rights in Islam.

The second axis: women's rights in law.

The third axis: women's rights in education and work.

Fourth axis: Women's rights in international and local organizations.

The symposium came out with several recommendations, including the need to develop solutions and proposals to advance the reality of women and solve their problems

As well as continuing to hold seminars and workshops in cooperation with human rights organizations to raise community awareness of the rights of individuals and women in particular.

The dialogue symposium witnessed interventions made by the attendees to find some solutions, treatments and proposals to

enhance the role of women and empower them economically, socially and politically.
